## Broadview Subway Station Modifications Phase 1 - Streetcar Track Reconstruction Beginning September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2003

At a TTC Community Information Meeting held on June 11, 2003, the TTC advised the community of a multi-phase two-year plan to improve service operations and public access at Broadview Station. During all phases of construction, Broadview Station will remain accessible to pedestrians, with subway operations remaining unaffected.

Starting on September 2<sup>nd</sup> through to November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2003, the first phase of these modifications will begin. The City of Toronto Works and Emergency Services Department and the TTC will be reconstructing the streetcar tracks from an area immediately south of the Broadview/Danforth intersection north into the Broadview Station and on Erindale Avenue. A new second streetcar track and passenger platform will be added at the station. During this work, buses will replace streetcar service on Broadview Avenue north of Gerrard Street. (*See Transit Service Changes below*). Full streetcar service to Broadview Station will be restored (504 Dundas and 504 King routes) on the morning of November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2003.

The site will be secured with plywood fencing (hoarding) for the duration of the station modification work.

**TRANSIT SERVICE CHANGES:** The following changes to service will occur between August 31<sup>st</sup> and November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2003 to accommodate the track reconstruction. **See map below.** Up-to-date service details are also available by calling the **TTC Information Line at (416) 393-INFO.**

- 504 KING STREETCARS will divert in the in the east end, via: east on King Street, north on Parliament Street, east on Dundas Street, south on Broadview Avenue to Queen Street to regular routing.
- 505 DUNDAS STREETCARS will divert in the east end, via: east on Dundas Street, north on Parliament Street, east on Gerrard Street, south on Broadview Avenue and west on Dundas Street to regular routing.
- 504/505 KING/DUNDAS REPLACEMENT BUS SERVICE will operate from the Broadview Station to the King/Parliament intersection area. Via: south on Broadview Avenue, west on Queen Street, west on King Street, south on Parliament Street, west on Front Street, north on Berkeley Street, east on King Street, back to normal routing to Broadview Station.

**Note:** As a result of lane restrictions during stages of the track work, the replacement bus service will be diverted around the construction via nearby streets in the Broadview/Danforth area in order to access and leave the Broadview Station, i.e. a portion of Playter Boulevard and Hurndale Avenue. In addition, southbound lane restrictions will occur on Broadview Avenue at Danforth Avenue during certain stages of the track construction. The southbound replacement bus service from Broadview Station will be re-routed during this lane restriction.

- 303 DON MILLS NIGHT BUS ROUTE will divert when the south side of the Broadview/Danforth intersection is closed to southbound traffic. Buses will divert both ways via: south on Pape Avenue, west on Riverdale Avenue, south on Carlaw Avenue, west on Gerrard Street and south on Broadview Avenue to route.

**Work Hours:**

Generally, construction work will take place between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, with weekend and after-hours work as required. During TTC rail installation work, shifts will operate 24 hours, up to 7 days a week. The work by TTC track crews includes delivery of rail, rail installation and rail welding. Efforts will be made to keep noise to a minimum. All timelines are weather dependent.

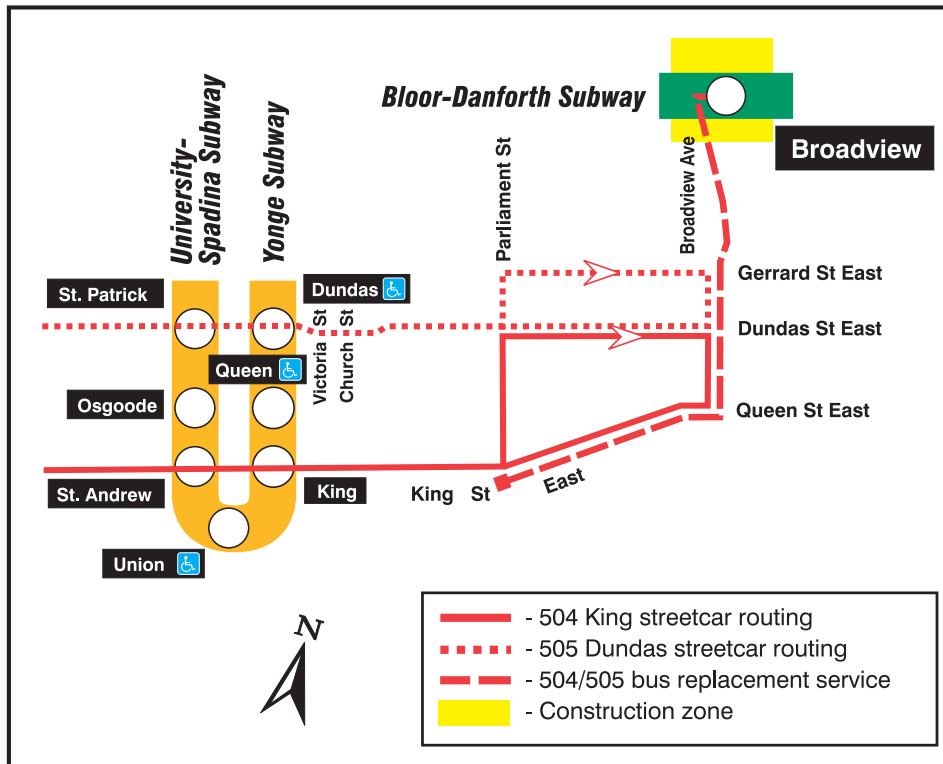
**Lane Restrictions:**

Lane restrictions will be in effect throughout stages of the track work. Track work at the Broadview/Danforth intersection is scheduled for Monday, September 22<sup>nd</sup> to Friday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2003 and will require lane restrictions during that period. This intersection work will be carried out on around-the-clock basis. One lane of traffic in each direction on Danforth Avenue will be maintained.
