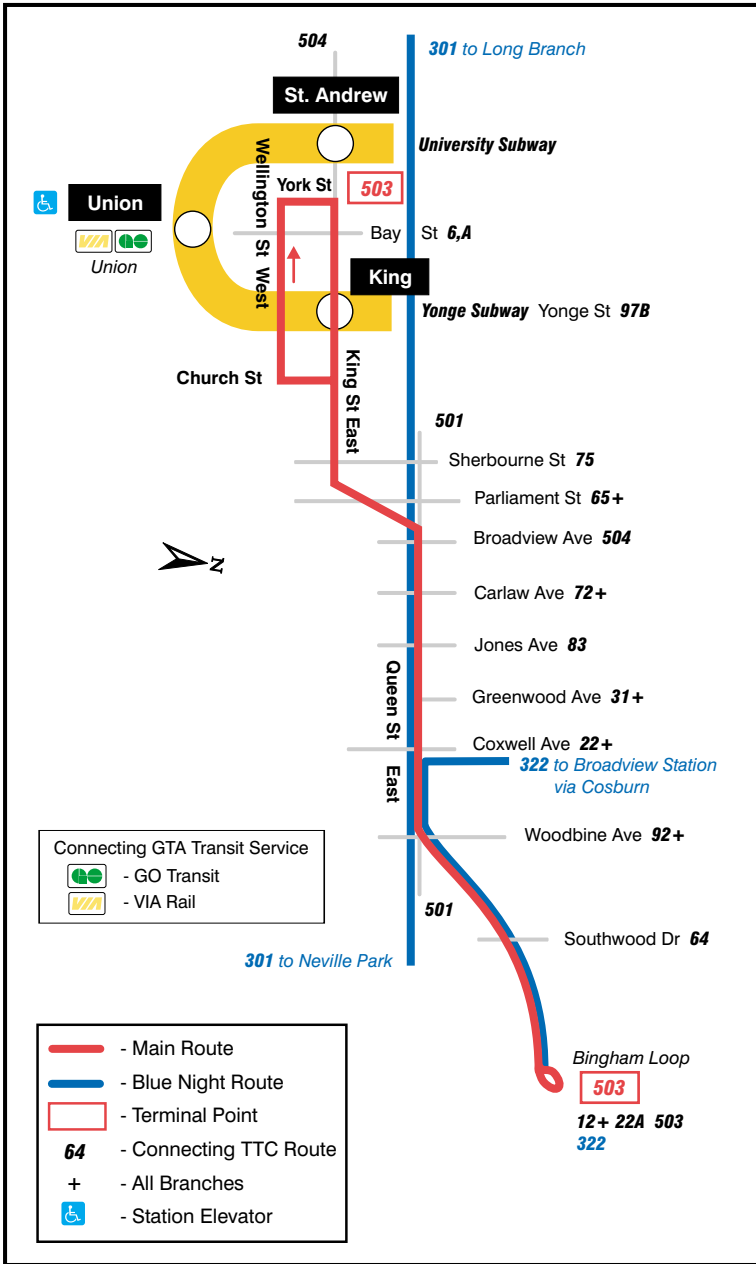

### How to TTC to where you're going?

Call 416-393-4636. Operator assistance (8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.); recorded and fax information 24 hours, seven days a week.

### Request Stop Program

Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

### TTC's Blue Night Network

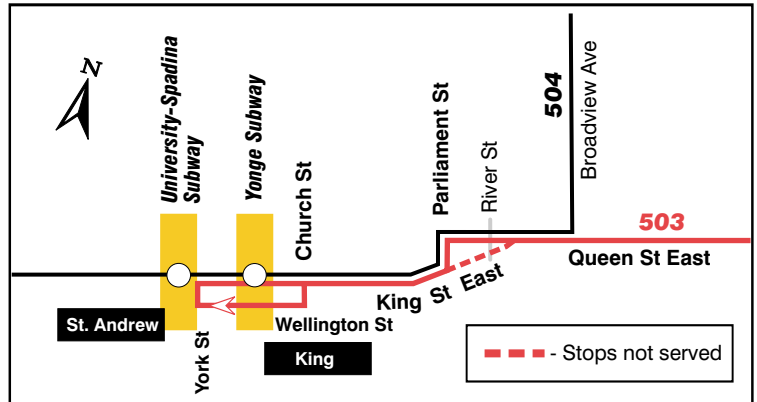
Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.

## Effective February 24, 2003

### Routing change - Construction

Starting Monday, February 24, streetcars will be rerouted during track welding, on King Street between River Street and Ashby Place (just south of Queen Street), in preparation for the King Street track project.

**Streetcars will divert both ways** via King, Parliament Street, Queen Street and Broadview Avenue, as shown below.

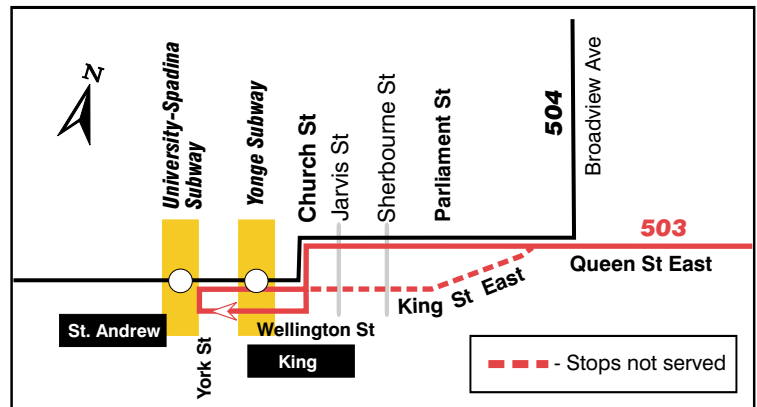


## Effective March 10\*, 2003

### Routing change - Rail Welding & Construction

Starting Monday, March 10, streetcars will be rerouted during track welding on King Street between Jarvis Street and Frederick Street (west of Sherbourne).

**Streetcars will divert both ways** via King, Church Street, Queen Street and Broadview Avenue, as shown below.



\* scheduled start date, weather permitting.

**Additional route diversions as track reconstruction progresses. Scheduled completion - October 2003.**
