

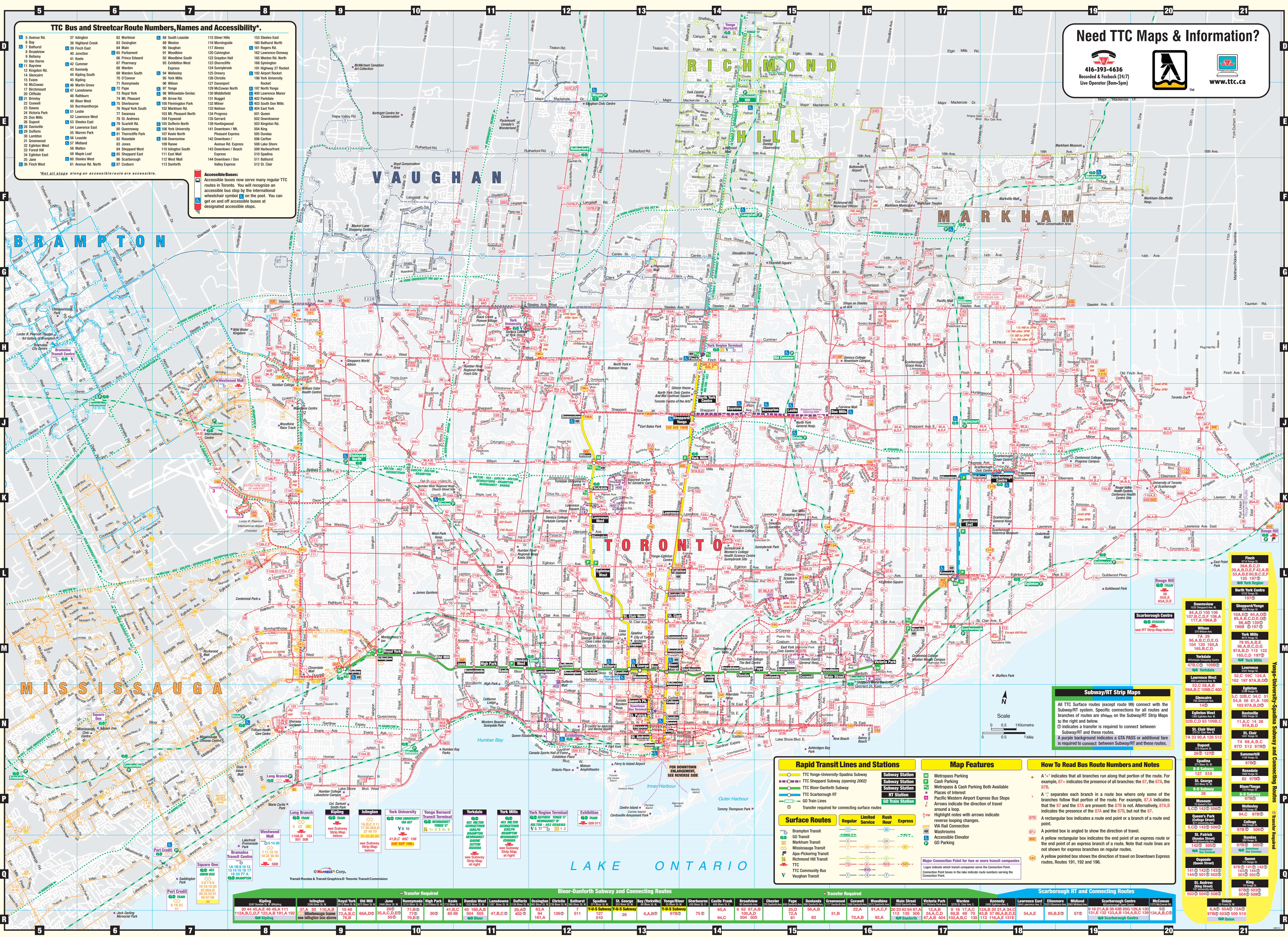

TTC Bus and Streetcar Route Numbers, Names and Accessibility\*. Table listing routes 1-113 with accessibility icons.

Accessible Buses: Accessible buses now serve many regular TTC routes in Toronto. You will recognize an accessible bus stop by the international wheelchair symbol on the post. You can get on and off accessible buses at designated accessible stops.



Subway/RT Strip Maps: List of routes for various subway and rapid transit stations including Downsview, North York Centre, York Mills, etc.

Subway/RT Strip Maps: All TTC Surface routes (except route 99) connect with the Subway/RT system. Specific connections for all routes and branches of routes are shown on the Subway/RT Strip Maps to the right and below.

Rapid Transit Lines and Stations: Legend for TTC Yonge-University-Spadina Subway, TTC Sheppard Subway, TTC Bloor-Danforth Subway, TTC Scarborough RT, and TTC Trillium Transit.

Map Features: Legend for Metropass & Cash Parking, Places of Interest, Pacific Western Airport Express Bus Stops, Arrows indicate the direction of travel, and other symbols.
