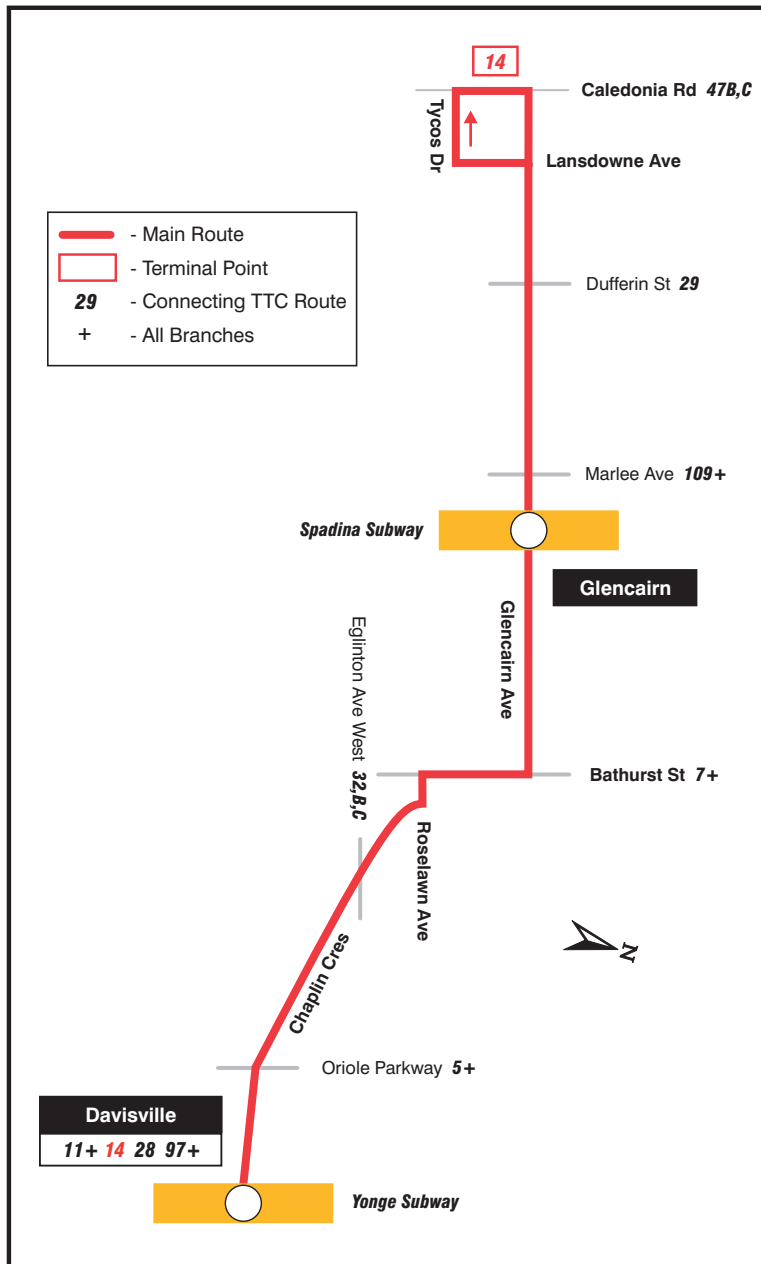

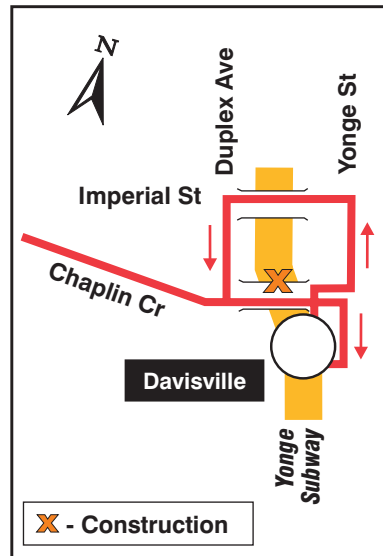

Temporary Routing Change - During Construction

The Chaplin Crescent bridge over the Yonge subway will be rebuilt, beginning April 15 and lasting until the end of October. Due to construction barriers on the bridge, buses will not be able to make the westbound turn out of Davisville Station. As a result, westbound buses will be diverted via Yonge Street, Imperial Street and Duplex Avenue, as shown. Additional running time will be added during the peak periods, and the service will change from every 16 minutes to every 20 minutes.

Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

TTC's Blue Night Network

Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.
