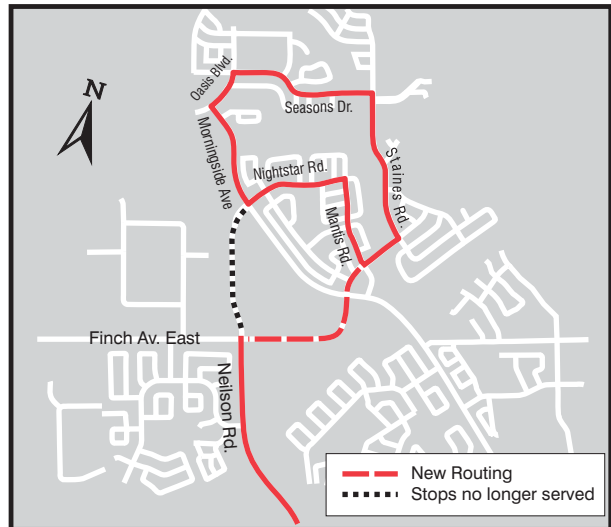

Route change

The route will be changed to more directly serve the Morningside Heights community. All buses, at all times of the week, will operate in both directions via Finch Avenue East, between Neilson Road and Morningside Avenue/Staines Road. *Service will be removed from the short section of Neilson Road between Finch Avenue and Morningside Avenue.* There will be no change to trip times or service levels.



Service increase

Service will be increased during most times of the week, to reduce crowding.

In the morning peak period from Monday to Friday the service will be improved from every 8 minutes 45 seconds to every 8 minutes.

In the midday from Monday to Friday the service will be improved from every 15 minutes to every 10 minutes.

In the afternoon peak period from Monday to Friday the service will be improved from every 9 minutes 15 seconds to every 7 minutes 30 seconds.

In the early evening from Monday to Friday, between approximately 7:00 and 8:30 p.m., the service will be improved from every 15 minutes to every 9 minutes.

During the morning on Saturdays, the service will be improved from every 12 minutes to every 10 minutes. During the afternoon on Saturdays, the service will be improved from every 8 minutes 45 seconds to every 8 minutes. During the early evening on Saturdays, between approximately 7:00 and 8:30 p.m., service will be improved from every 15 minutes to every 10 minutes.

During the morning on Sundays and holidays the service will be improved from every 15 minutes to every 12 minutes. During the afternoon on Sundays and holidays, the service will be improved from every 12 minutes to every 8 minutes 45 seconds.

Please check posted schedules at subway stations and at transfer points on your route.



Accessible service is provided on this route. Not all stops along an accessible route are accessible.
